In accordance with Section 102(w) of the Energy Act 2006, a person convicted of retailing petroleum products above the maximum levels will be liable to a fine not exceeding Kenya shillings one million, or the withdrawal of their operating licence or both.

The Commission is working closely with other government agencies and members of the public to ensure compliance. To this end, some individuals found retailing petroleum at prices above the allowed maximum prices last review period, have been arrested and charged in court while others are expected to be arraigned in court this week.
